The language is challenging but not impossible.

They offer strong themes (morality, justice, courage, resilience).

They provide excellent material for descriptive writing models.

Tip for parents:

Children don't need to struggle through the full Victorian texts at age 11.

They can:

Read abridged or illustrated editions (e.g. Usborne, Puffin Classics).

Use summaries or retellings (e.g. Michael Morpurgo's retellings of classics, or the Classic Starts series).

Watch thoughtful adaptations (films, stage plays, or BBC/CBBC versions) to reinforce plot and themes.
